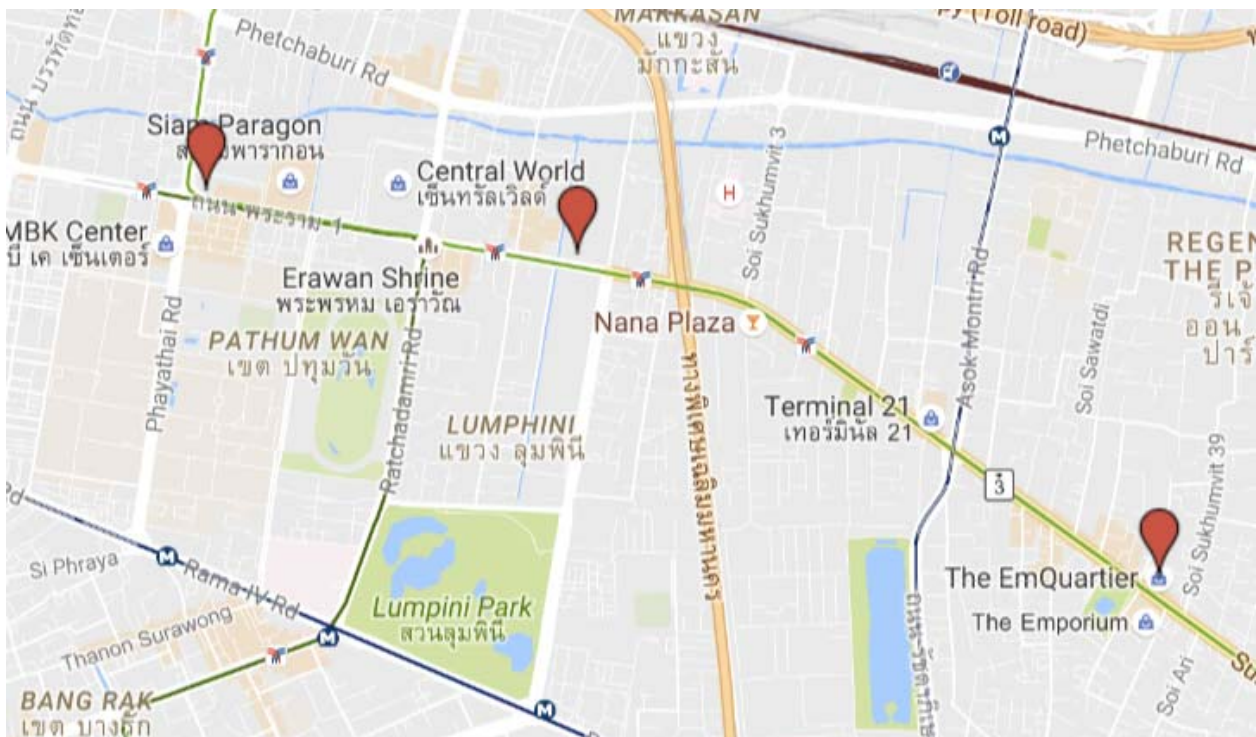
Project Overview
